Values

Immaculate Heart Catholic Primary School encourages and supports students to represent our school by wearing the correct school uniform with pride. The school uniform provides the students and school community with a sense of identity, dignity and respect for themselves and their school.



Purpose

Immaculate Heart Catholic Primary School requires students to maintain a high standard of dress and grooming as a matter of priority. In doing so they will present an appropriate image of the school to the broader community and to each other. The purpose of this policy is to:

- To promote equality amongst all students.
- To further develop a sense of pride in, and identification with our school.
- To provide durable clothing that is cost effective and practical for our school environment.
- To maintain and enhance the positive image of self and the school in the community.

POLICY STATEMENT

Dress Standards

So as to maintain a high standard of dress, the following specific regulations must be adhered to:

Uniform

The Appropriate uniform must be worn in the appropriate manner at all times:

- Formal school uniform must be worn on days it is required. This includes wearing the designated 'school hat with new, colourful logo'.
- Sports uniform may be worn on designated days.
- In line with the SunSmart Policy, hats are to be worn during all outdoor activities or if playing at break times (no hat, no play).
- The current school logo is the only logo to appear on items of the school uniform.
- All Immaculate Heart uniforms are available for purchase at the school uniform shop

Jewellery

- Make-up, hair colour, nail polish and temporary tattoos do not form part of Immaculate Heart Catholic Primary School uniform.
- A simple crucifix may be worn on a chain around the neck. Unacceptable jewellery will be confiscated by staff and returned at an appropriate time.
- One set of studs / sleepers (per ear) and a watch may be worn. This applies to both boys and girls.

Appearance Standards:

Immaculate Heart does not accept hairstyles which draw attention to the individual. This is the underlying regulation regarding hair at Immaculate Heart. Hairstyles that are deemed extreme and unacceptable include;

- Blade 2 length is the shortest length acceptable for 'all over' and also 'under' cuts.
- Mohawks
- Dreadlocks
- Tracks
- Rats tails

These are not acceptable in any form. (Principal has final discretion.)



The following specific regulations must be adhered to so as to ensure the above statement is maintained.

The parents/carers, and students each have specific responsibilities to arrive at school, dressed in the appropriate uniform. Teachers have the responsibility to monitor students to ensure they are:

- 1. Dressed in the correct clothing
- 2. Wearing the uniform according to standards outlined in this and associated documents.
- 3. Ensure students present themselves in appropriate school uniform and communicate any difficulties with the school
- 4. Ensure students are adhering to both the dress and appearance standards outlined above
- 5. All items of school uniform are to be marked clearly with student's name.
- 6. In the case of a student being out of uniform, parents are to write a note explaining reasons for being out of uniform indicating a time frame for problem to be rectified.

Student Responsibilities:

- To arrive at and depart from school in full school uniform.
- At after school care or outside school while still in school uniform, students are expected to wear
 the uniform correctly (keeping in mind, the SunSmart policy). While in uniform, students are still
 representing the school.
- Students (either boys or girls) with shoulder length hair or longer, are to wear it tied back with modest accessories such as ribbons/scrunchies that reflect the school colours.
- Natural hair colours only are permitted. (Principal has final discretion)
- Fashion accessories are limited to 'sleepers / stud style earrings' (One only and in both ears) and watches.

School Responsibilities:

- Monitor the students to ensure they are in correct uniform and also wearing it appropriately.
- Seek clarification from students who are not in correct uniform in the form of parent note.
- In the absence of a note, students will be asked why they are out of uniform and if required, parents will be contacted to explain reasons why the uniform standards are not being met. (See associated documents)
- In the event of non-compliance with any responsibilities within this policy:
 - Parents will be contacted
 - o Consequences for breach of uniform policy will be at the principal's discretion



UNIFORM DETAILS

"Full school uniform is expected to be worn every day"

 Formal Uniform Shirt: Maroon checked with school logo Shorts: Mid grey above knees Socks: Grey with maroon and gold stripe Shoes: Black school shoe with leather/leather look uppers Jumper: Maroon fleece jacket with Immaculate Heart Catholic Primary School logo
 Hat Reversable house bucket hat with Immaculate Heart Catholic Primary School logo School coloured hair bands for long hair.
 Sports Uniform Shirt: Maroon shirt, gold collar and Immaculate Heart School Logo Shorts: Maroon and Gold Stripe Socks: White I.H.S logo socks Shoes: Black athletic school shoes

Optional:

- School badge / leadership badges can be worn with school uniform.
- Senior shirts are available for Yr6 students to be worn on days allocated.
- On Friday's, students may wear their house-coloured shirt (worn with the school logo sports uniform only).

Other:

- Winter wear Boys maroon track pants can be worn; Girls can wear maroon tights or maroon track pants.
- INTERSCHOOL years 4-6: children will be loaned interschool shirts for school representation (to be returned at the conclusion of interschool sports).
- Soccer students will be required to wear knee high maroon school football socks (available at uniform shop) to wear with interschool uniform, school sports shorts to be worn with interschool shirt (provided). Shin pads need to be purchased separately. Students may wear their personal soccer shoes for interschool sport.
- Netball Maroon visor (available from uniform shop), Interschool shirt (provided), maroon school sport shorts and white I.H.S logo socks. Black joggers or sandshoes.

Prep Uniform – Boys and Girls (sports uniform)

- Shirt: Maroon and Gold Polo with school logo
- Shorts: GIRLS Maroon sports shorts with I.H.S logo, BOYS Maroon and Gold Stripe shorts
- Shoes: Black joggers or sandshoes with Velcro instead of laces
- Socks: White I.H.S logo socks
- Hat: Reversable House Bucket hat with Immaculate Heart Catholic Primary School logo
